

There was a wonderful entry & it was a happy day for me. My only regret was that I had to leave so many nice dogs out of the cards.

Puppy (9): 1 Wallace's Morenish George. I liked him, well matured & up to size, showing & moving well, res CC; 2 Cook's Famecheck Farrago, another well balanced pup, lacked the drive in going away; 3 Collett's Cedarfell Mink, made a lovely trio, perhaps lacked the confidence of those above. **Jun D (4):** 1 F Farrago; 2 Fisher's Lindenhall Discard, sound with excellent bone; 3 Lemon's Citrus Truman, have always liked him but did not appear at his best. **Nov D (7):** 1 M Georgia; 2 F Farrago; 3 Wysocki's Rhiana Ambassador, I liked his head & conformation, did not move so well going away. **Limit D (9):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Bernard, I liked him & found him good in all the essentials; 2 Denis's Sittig Goshall of Branton, I liked very much during puppyhood & feel that he is taking a long time to mature. Would not use his ears; 3 Jeffrey's Quakerdown Quirang, I feel that this dog was not disgraced here. Very cobby with ample furnishing, used to advantage. **Open D (4):** 1 CC & BOB, Thomson's Waldeshouse Willoughby, I liked very much, good head, nice expression, plenty of hard

coat, tail set right on top & moved with drive; 2 Baird's Dundyan Westerner, similar type to above, would have liked more furnishings all round; 3 Cook's Famecheck Hallmark, well known & needs no further comment from me.

Puppy B (9): 1 Bertram's Highgate Poppel & what a poppel! Really outstanding in a good class of puppies, took my eye winning all the way including the CC; 2 Dennis's Blue Pippet of Branton, another nice puppy but not the maturity of the winner; 3 Fisher's Lindenhall Donna, 9 month baby, beautifully balanced, hard white coat, I feel we shall hear more of her. **Jun B (7):** 1 B H Poppel; 2 Cook's Famecheck Dresden, lovely cobby bitch with great maturity, excels in head & expression, short body & good tail set; 3 Wysocki's Snowships of Sursucmorda, another nice bitch with good head, balance & coat. **Nov B (9):** 1 F Dresden; 2 Blue Pippet of B; 3 Seamon's Sunket Silvi of Sursucmorda nice in all the essentials but failed in front to those above. **Limit B (10):** 1 H Poppel; 2 F Dresden; 3 Brownridge & Hink's McHylian Crystons Mandy, I thought this bitch was looking well. **Open B (9):** 1 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bawbee, lovely bitch whose day will surely come, well balanced, coat of the hardest texture, res CC; 2 F Dresden; 3 Coy's Whitebriar Jillian, another I have always used, as has not quite come into full bloom.

CHAMPION FAMECHECK HALLMARK

is proud of his many winning children, particularly this week's winners F STERLING (Jun Warrant, Best in Show, Many Best Puppy awards), BEICH CC at BIRMINGHAM, F MAN O'MARK (Jun Warrant, several Best in Shows), 5 FIRSTS AND BEST IN SHOW next day at SOUTHBEND Open Show in record entry, and F JILLETTE, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW at HAMPTSTEAD. F STERLING is from the same litter as F TRADEMARK (3 Firsts Birmingham, many other firsts), AM CH F PLATINIUM (unbeaten at her 7 shows in USA) and F TOPMARK (winner of Best Dog in Show, Best Puppy, etc) before recent export to USA. These 4 still only 16 months, from a repeat of the mating which produced CH F BERNARD and 3 other Best in Show winners, F MAN O'MARK's litter mates are CH F MAID TO ORDER and the record-breaking puppy, F MAID TO MEASURE (Jun Warrant at 8 months). Now exported to USA. JILLETTE is from the same litter as F SUPER SILVER (many Best Puppy awards including WHWT Ch Show), and two exported brothers, F STAINLESS and F BLADE, who are expected to do very well in USA. These three litters out of 3 very different bitches are typical of the stock being sired by HALLMARK, who is fast proving himself the outstanding sire of the decade, with winners in every litter. Have yet to find a bitch he doesn't suit. At 4 years he will head SIRE OF SIX CHAMPIONS and his first grand-children are winning—F AIR HOSTESS (F CC, 3 Res CCs), F FERVENT (Res CC, Best in Shows, etc). Fee now 10 gns—and well worth it! One champion bitch has already had a second litter by him as the owner was so pleased with the first. After disappointing litter by dog from another kennel, Champion bitches accepted at reduced fee of six guineas. Also reduction for approved bitches if I can buy back the litter. Other winning dogs at stud here, near Carlisle, near Workson and in Wales.

Puppy D (5): 1 Wilson's Birkfell's South Pacific, typical head, good eye, neat well placed ears, short cropped, good coat, moved soundly; 2 Milner's Birkfell Sound of Mavic, similar type to winner, not surprising as I now find he is litter brother, perhaps bigger, but still has the essentials, moved soundly; 3 Webster's Palmcourt Loganberry of Balmaha, good skull, dark eyes, neat ears, just a little overdone in forehead, sound bone, moved well. **Jun D (3):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Trademark, good headed youngster, very sound in front, hard coat, short strong body, sound; 2 Farthing's The Lord of Wothesley, good typical head, sound throughout, moved well. Not quite as good in coat as winner; 3 Bryan's Alvermar Autocent, good eye and ears, little overdone in forehead in body and movement behind, but failed in front to those above. **Nov D (7):** 1 F Trademark; 2 B S Pacific; 3 B Sound of Music. **Undergrad D (5):** 1 F Trademark; 2 Graham and Hazell's Lasara Leading Man, good type in many respects, moved soundly, good coat. Perhaps a little feminine in head and not too well off for bone; 3 Pullen's Fartstop Cavalier, quite typical in head and expression, decent front and topline, in rather heavier condition than those above and although sound in front failed somewhat in hind action. **Grad D (6):** 1 Barry's Inchell Irony, good head, eye and expression, nice neck, shoulders and front, level topline, hard coat, moved well; 2 F Trademark; 3 Boucher's Hrelaptyde Bumper Bundle, typical head, good expression, neat ears, sound bone, good front and topline. Failed a little in hind action to those above. **Limit D (10):** 1 Keasey's Pillerton Prosper, good head, ears and expression, nicely placed shoulders, moved gaily and with soundness throughout; 2 Hampton's Peech of Marank, good head and expression, sound body and quarters. Failed slightly in front to winner; 3 Cook's Famecheck Nobility, typical head and expression, short compact body, good coat. Failed a little in movement to those above. **Open D (7):** very good class of high quality, 1 Owen's Ch Alpinessy Sonata, oghr size, excellent head, eye and

expression, good shoulders, legs and feet, short compact body, hard coat, moved well. **CC and BOB:** 2 Wallace's Ch Morenish George, in excellent form, very close to winner. Good head, correct shoulder placement, sound legs and feet, hard coat, moved soundly. I thought winner had a slight edge on quality but very little separated them. **Res CC:** 3 Beggs's Lynnhills Proklee Picador, good sound terrier, excellent head and expression, good legs and feet, short deep body, hard coat, moved well. Just a size larger than those above.

Puppy B (5): 1 Morgan's Ballacoor Belladonna, good head and expression, sound front and behind, moved well, hard coat. Perhaps a shade long in back but a quality puppy; 2 Bryan's Alvermar Adela, neat head, well placed ears, short compact body, hard coat. Not quite so good in front as winner; 3 Cook's Famecheck Elanders, although quite typical in head and expression and good in body, was rather light in bone and not in her best coat. **Jun B (5):** 1 Copeland's Drumcote Bonnie, typical bitch, pleasing head, nice neck and shoulders, good body, hard coat, moved well; 2 Lyon's Allseire Glenyale Topax, good skull and forehead, rather full in eye, sound front, hard coat, moved well; 3 Varley's Yelran Gay Tartan Treasure, fairly good in head, nice neck and shoulders, moved soundly but failed in coat texture. **Nov B (10):** 1 D Bonnie; 2 Gallagher's Sheldayn Sugar-nut, sound throughout, nice head and expression, good front and quarters, moved well; 3 Pritchard's Melwyn Lady Jane, attractive quality bitch, good front, moved well. Not in her best coat at present. **Undergrad D (11):** 1 D Bonnie; 2 Sill's Proene Sweet Sue, sweet head, good expression, excellent neck and shoulders, sound body, moved well. Coat not at its best; 3 Wilson and Fisher's Lindenhall Citrus Twistletoe, fairly good head, neck and shoulders well placed, hard coat. Beaten in substance and quality of bone. **Grad B (5):** 1 P S Sue; 2 Cook's Famecheck Treble Chance, nice size with quality and soundness; typical head and expression, hard coat, short body; 3 L C Twistletoe. **Limit B (6):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Sterling, I thought this bitch about the right size with ample substance and quality. Well balanced, round throughout, very neat head, good expression, hard coat, moved and showed well. Challenged for the CC and won it; 2 Morgan's Ballacoor Ballacora, another quality bitch, good shoulders and front, quality bone, short body, level top, moved soundly; 3 Keasey's Pillerton Pixie, made up a trio of very nice bitches. Typical head, ears and expression, good shoulders, short body, hard coat. **Open B (9):** 1 Coy's Cedarfell Moon Witch, appealed particularly in head, expression and general soundness, very good neck, shoulders and front, grand quarters, moved well. **Res CC:** 2 Milner's Ch Realim Rachael, short compact body, good coat, sound mover, neat head and ears, showed well; 3 Cook's Famecheck Air Hostess, good head and ear carriage, short body, level topline, hard coat. Lost a little in strength of bone to those above.

WEST HIGHLAND WHITES—There was a wonderful entry of 46 from 25 dogs & I felt very privileged to be able to handle some of our best. I did not find one bad mouth & temperaments were excellent. I wished I had more cards, especially in the puppy class. **Puppy (8):** 1 Dennis's Blue Cloud of Branton, mature young lady & very like her mum, beautiful balance, moved & showed well. Must have a future; 2 Lemon's Citrus Truman, attractive dog, lovely reach of neck, good shoulders & front, harsh white jacket. Unfortunately he was used by an in-season bitch; 3 Graham & Hazell's Lasara Linda Belle, good neck, front, coat & colour, moved soundly. **Nov (13):** 1, 2 repeat; 3 Black's Strathairie Silver Dawn, neat little bitch, good expression, body & coat, moved & showed well. **Grad (8):** 1 Milner's Lindenhall Drumbul, & stylish quality dog, lovely head & expression, good front, very short back. Will do well; 2 Coy's Whitebriar Jillian, good type bitch, bigish but everything in balance, short back, good outline; 3 L Linda Belle. **Spec Yearling (5):** 1 L Drumbul; 2 L Linda Belle; 3 S Silver Dawn. **Open (6):** 1 & BOB Zekschewski's Int Ch Monsieur Aus Der Florange, beautiful head & expression, good bone & coat, sound mover & such an attractive showman; 2 Graham & Hazell's Lasara Louise, I liked this bitch's outline & balance, lovely neck, shoulders & front, sound mover, straight white jacket; 3 Brook's Strathairie Swiss Miss, good head, expression & body, very white coat, steady mover. Well presented as always.

Puppy (9): 1 Bertram's Highgate Poppel, amazing puppy, looks as if she has everything. I'm sure she has a great future; 2 Wender's Beadonfield Deborah, very attractive, good body & coat, shows well; 3 Grad's Hallmark Monarch, another nice puppy, nice size, moved & showed well. Will improve further with maturity. **Nov (13):** 1 Barry's Inchell Iacha, good head, nice eye, topline & coat, well presented, good movement; 2 H Poppel; 3 Bryan's Alvermar Alberta, nice type with good outline, moved & showed well. **Grad D (10):** 1 I Iacha; 2 Reed's The Squire of Cordrons, very smart, good front, head, eye & coat, moves well; 3 Stevenson's Parkendot Bobby Dazzler, good type, nice shoulder, legs & coat, in good order. **Limit D (15):** 1 Jeffrey's Quakerdown Quirang, excellent dog with very good head, eye & expression, short level back, good coat & an excellent mover; 2 I Iacha; 3 Baird's Dundyan Westerner, stylish, good head, outlook & topline. One which we will hear of again. **Open D (12):** 1 CC & BOB, Bertram's Highgate Prank, in first-class condition, good coat, lovely head with good dark eye & expression. A real snowman; 2 & res CC, Thomson's Waldeshouse Willoughby, good type with grand neck, shoulders & coat, sound movement; 3 Cook's Famecheck Hallmark, very short coupled, good head & expression. Just fails a little in reach of neck, showed well. **Grad B (10):** 1 Oatane's Panduro Tinker, nice type, good coat, eye & expression, moved & showed well; 2 A Alberta; 3 Duella Lovell Launda, good coat, head, eye & expression, moves well. **Limit B (12):** 1 P Tinker; 2 Barry's Inchell Balmaha, pleasing type, good head & front, excellent overall appearance; 3 Brownridge's Macnylan Crystone Mandy, A useful bitch, moved & showed well. **Open B (11):** 1 & CC, Cook's Famecheck Verana, high class, good front, fine reach of neck, good topline & hindquarters; 2 & res CC, Clarend's Birkfell Seafire, quality bitch, well laid back shoulders, moved & showed well; 3 M Mandy.
