Puppy D (3): 1 Farthing's My Count of Weatherley, outstanding puppy and all the better for having shed some puppy fat, excellent in every way, head, body and coat. Shall be very surprised if he does not eventually achieve top honours; 2 Hartwell's St. Loves Offenbark, good type, failed in front; 3 Wysocki's Sao of Sunsumcorda, with more confidence should do well. **Nov D (4):** 1 Graham's Larasa Lysander, good head and body shape. Needs more flesh on his ribs; 2 Lemon's Citrus Trueman, much to like

about him, sound coming and going. Like winner needs more substance. 3 Bryan's Alvenmar Admiral, stocky little dog, seems too short of neck, good hard jacket. **Grad D (6):** 1 My Count of W; 2 Wysocki's Rhanfa Ambassador, pleasing head, nice body and coat, showed and moved well, the size I like; 3 Winder's Beaconfield Debonair, very smart but too low to ground for my liking. **Minor limit D (3):** 1, res CC, Cook's Knight Errant, good head piece, nice body, level topline. A little upset with the heat which was very intense at this time; 2 Graham and Thompson's Perfect O' Petriburg, disliked the heat, very pleasing head. Could do with more substance, very white coat. **Open D (6):** 1 Kearsley's Ch Pillerton Peterman, looking in excellent form and stood way out from the rest, with his fame so well established there is nothing left to say. CC and BOB; 2 Wilson's Maenab of Balmaha, should have a future but I feel is not yet at his best, moves and shows well; 3 Cook's Famecheck Bernard, smart dog, well known.

Puppy B (11): 1 Kearsley's Pillerton Pixie, the sort to capture all hearts, beautiful head, neat ears, lovely neckline, good body for age, shows and enjoys every minute of it; 2 Friehard's Pillerton Picture, later sister to winner and so little to choose between them. Not quite the body of Pixie; 3 Brownridge and Hink's MacHylan Melinda, good head, neck and shoulders. A little long in back. **Nov B (12):** 1 Milner's Renlim Rachael, lovely type, beautifully presented, correct size and style. With maturity will always trouble the best; 2 P Pixie; 3 James's Jamart Judith, rather huffy bitch but I loved her head, expression and general soundness. **Grad B (8):** 1 Goulay's Danlea Decorative, real charmer, attractive head with neat ears, carried to well, corky body and good coat, smart mover; 2 Ingram's Woodpuddle Baubles, similar of above; 3 Morgan's Ballacour Ballerina, made up a trio of lovely

young bitches. Not in such good coat as winners. **Minor limit B (5):** 1 D Decorative 2 B Ballerina; 3 Hartwell's St. Loves Capability Brown, have always liked but seemed a little slack in front today. **Open B (9):** 1, CC, Welch's Glengyle Tuggles, looking better than I have ever seen her, good head, well furnished, lovely body and hard coat, muscular thighs that speak of exercise and plenty of freedom. Nevertheless had to fight hard to beat 2 Black's Ch Strathairlie Swiss Miss, her white coat dazzled one in the sunshine. **Res CC:** 3 Griffin's Shandwin Sazariah, good one with sweet head, lovely neck and shoulders. Seemed a trifle down on pasterns and inclined to turn her feet out.

Pleasant exhibitors and lot of really good dogs to judge, made the long journey to Bath worth while. **Puppy (13):** 1 Farthing's My Count of Weatherley, a really good one to handle, most promising, born showman, should have a rosy future; 2 Kearsley's Pillerton Pixie, good one, lovely head and expression, neck and shoulders, all one could wish for, nice body, level topline, moved well; 3 Cook's Famecheck Maid To Measure, nicely made, plenty of bone and substance, good head and expression.

very harsh coat, moved well. **Nov D (7):** 1 My Count of W; 2 Collett's Cedarfell Man-o-Minx, I liked very much, good head, eye and mouth, nice neck and shoulders, plenty of bone and substance; 3 Fenlon's Royal Skipper of Ranroth, smart young dog, only needs time, moved and showed well, nice size. **Grad D (6):** 1 My Count of W; 2 Budden's Glengordon Monar, matured, grand body and coat, lovely eye, head and expression, tail set right, good mover; 3 Lewis's Glengordon Monopoly, well made, lots to like, handles well. **Limit D (8):** 1 Cook and Siltuast's Famecheck Bernard, really good dog to handle, lovely head and eye, excellent bone and substance, well ribbed, short back, dense harsh coat; 2 Ellis's Slitrig Simon of Lynwood, I liked very much, in good condition, beautifully presented; 3 Watson's Dunearn Pinkholme Panorama, good upstanding dog of the right type and size, handles well. **Open D (2):** 1 Wheeler's Ch Alpinegay Impresario, it was a pleasure to go over this well-known dog and to award him the CC and BOB; 2 D P Panorama.

Nov B (15): 1 Wheeler's Alpinegay Quartette, took the lead in this strong class, I liked her very much, will be heard more of, in good condition; 2 Milner's Renlim Rachael, nice young bitch, lovely head and expression, good front and shoulders, short back, sound mover; 3 P Pixie. **Grad B (10):** 1 Dennis's Bluecloud of Branston, nice bitch to go over, lovely head, eye and mouth, will go a long way; 2 Goulay's Danlea Decorative, another really good one, true to type, in excellent condition; 3 A Quartette. **Limit B (10):** 1 Beesley's Ch Masquerade of Bamburg, so well known needs no further comment from me. Very sound bitch, in perfect condition; 2 Bluecloud of B; 3 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bumble, I have always liked, enjoys every minute of a show, lovely type, very sound. **Open B (8):** 1 Coy's Whitebriar Jillan, the best bitch I've seen or handled for a long time. I could not fault her. Beautifully presented. Puppy (7): 1 Brownridge and Hink's MacHylan Melinda, sweet bitch, nice expression, short back, lovely white coat; 2 Berry's Incherill Irony, promising puppy dog, good compact body, nice front, sound mover; 3 Thomson's Whitthouse, nice type, needs to body up. **Nov D (2):** 1 Wilson and Hackett's Whisky Armour, very well balanced, good head, body, fine showman, well presented; 2 Turner's Tasman Diplomat, very good head, sound body and quarters, moved well. **Grad D (8):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Knight Errant, good bone and substance, compact, excellent mover; 2 Fisher's Lindenhal Discard, good head, body, moved well; 3 Pardencol's Bobby Dazzler, attractive head and expression, pleasing outline, great showman. **Open D (11):** 1, CC and BOB, Wallace's Moresnah Geordie, quality dog, stood out in this class, has fulfilled his early promise, a worthy winner; 2 and res CC, Bennett's High Stile Frank, another top flight dog, with all the essentials; 3 Jeffrey's Quakerstown Quirang, completed a very nice trio. **Nov B (8):** 1 Leitch and Law's Robertson-Knowe Jacqueline, handled by myself; 2 Saxon's Quakerstown Quincelet, typical bitch, good neck and shoulder, short back, moved and showed well; 3 Little's Supetro Xmas Rose, good head and expression, nice topline and

coat. **Grad B (12):** 1 R K Jacqueline; 2 Milner's Renlim Rachael, quality exhibit, I liked very much, short back, good neck and shoulder, sound quarters, coat of right texture. Has shown better; 3 O Quincelet. **Open B (13):** 1 and CC, Griffin's Shandwin Sazariah, one I have admired, nice compact body, sound mover, lovely white coat, well presented; 2 and res CC, Cleland's Birkfell Solace, good, as usual from this select kennel, very attractive, sound condition. **Judge: G Leath. Puppy (13): 1 Sharpe's Enevale Goshell, very attractive bitch which has inherited many of her sire's good points, should do well; 2 Fenlon's Skipper of Ranroth, nice size, good head and expression, coat will improve, should do well later; 3 Lyon's Quakerstown Quimper, sorry to report on this one. **Nov D (6):** 1 Winder's Beaconfield Debonair, very showy little dog, good head, deep short body, good tall carriage, well presented and handled expertly; 2 Hampson's Victor of Manrank, another showy dog, just out of puppy, failed to win in head and expression. Will be better after he gets rid of his puppy fat and coat, should do well; 3 Skipper of R. **Grad D (6):** 1 and CC, Wilson's Maenab of Balmaha, my own, and I like him; 2 Denoh's Go Shell of Branston, nice dog, good outline, attractive head and expression, white coat, nicely presented and moved well; 3 Cook's Famecheck Knight Errant, nice size, good head, neck and body, harsh coat. A bit off-colour, did not move so well. **Open D (11):** 1 Maenab of B; 2 and res CC, Hampson's Snowgoblin, smart, showy, good harsh coat failed to younger dog in head, neck and shoulders, waiting for his third CC; 3 Thompson's Perfect O' Petriburg, I liked very much, nice size, good head and expression, good length of coat, nicely handled. Could have moved better, should make the upper house. **Nov B (10):** 1 Dennis's Beautiful Biddy of Branston, very nice bitch, lovely head and expression, lovely mover, very well presented, should make a champion; 2 Milner's Renlim Rachael, a bit on the small side for me, nicely presented, head not her fortune; 3 Graham and Hazell's Larasa Ladyhead, I liked for size, good head, neck and shoulders, should do well later. **Grad B (10):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Dresden, excellent type, beautiful head and expression, lovely reach of neck moulding into well placed shoulders, correct length of coat of right texture, moved very well; 2 Dennis's Blue Cloud of Branston, another very nice bitch which shows and handles very well, very much like her illustrious mother Ch Briarrose and moves like her; 3 Vernon's Lovely Lady of Balmaha, three lovely bitches. Good head nice reach of neck, straight front, very harsh white coat, moves and shows well. **Open B (12):** 1 CC and BOB, Cleland's Ch Birkfell Seafire, now a champion also gaining her 4th CC, beautiful bitch, thoroughly deserved all she got, because she certainly asked for it, congratulations; 2 and res CC, Welch's Glengyle Tuggles, another beautiful bitch, showing a little bit more weight than the winner but otherwise very nicely handled and presented, should make a champion; 3 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bawbee, three lovely bitches. A very nice entry where the bitches were more numerous than the dogs. Mouths were, on the whole, good but there were a number of faulty fronts and many turned out front feet. This latter is difficult to breed out but breeders will have to tackle this fault.

Puppy D (3): 1 Bouchier's Urstelspyde Bumper Bundle, nice sound puppy, good coat texture, shows well. Needs time to mature; 2 Cook's Famecheck Man-o-Mark, good coat, head and expression but tail low set; 3 Payne's St. Mellon Alfie, front did not please, turned feet out otherwise quite nice. **Nov D (4):** 1 Fisher's Lindenhal Discard, good movement, dark eye, good coat; 2 Collett's Cedarfell Man-o-Minx, fails in coat and colour to winner; 3 Clifford's Whinlark Woodsman, not moving well. **Grad D (4):** 1 C. Man-o-Minx; 2 Thomson's Perfect O'Petriburg, good showman, longer in back than winner, well presented; 3 W Woodsman. **Limit D (3):** 1, 2 repeat; 3 F Man O'Mark. **Open D (5):** 1 Kearsley's Ch Pillerton Peterman, came and conquered, really sound dog, correct size, coat in excellent condition, grand expression, CC and BOB; 2 Dennis's Slitrig Goshell of Branston, smaller dog and winner in good trim, sound movement, nice expression. Could do with more body condition. **res CC:** 3 Hampson's Show Goblin, I liked but not moving well in front.

Puppy B (10): 1 Coy's Cedarfell Moon Witch, very attractive, excellent coat, good eye and expression, moved well; 2 Lyon's Quakerstown Quimper, failed in colour to winner, otherwise sound; 3 Kearsley's Pillerton Pixie, I liked this puppy but very short of coat. **Nov B (15):** 1 Milner's Renlim Rachael, very nice, good white coat, sound mover, won this large class pretty easily; 2 O Quimper; 3 P Pixie. **Grad B (12):** 1 R Rachael; 2 Farnham's Sugar Dawn of Mahruf, very nice, showed and moved well, coat in good condition; 2 Morgan's Ballacour Ballerina, bonny with good colour and coat, would like higher tail set. **Limit B (7):** 1 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bumble, really good sound, moved and showed really well, **res CC:** 2 Sugar Dawn of M; 3 B Ballerina. **Open B (7):** 1 CC Dennis's Blue Cloud of Branston, the size I like, beautiful mover, lovely neck and shoulders. Could be a shade brighter in expression but it was very hot and the dogs felt it, good colour and texture of coat, should not be long collecting the other tickets; 2 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bawbee, very nice sound, coat in good order, moved and showed well; 3 Black's Ch Strathairlie Swiss Miss, good cham-
