Puppy D (6): 1 Farthing's My Count of Weatherly, nice size, compact body, very white coat. Rather slack in front movement; 2 Hampson's Victor of Marank, short backed, useful puppy, not so pleasing in front; 3 Fenton's Royal Skipper of Ranrou, nice head and front, topline spoiled by low-set tail. **Jun D (7):** 1 Thompson's Perfect O'Petriburg, nice size and outline, pleasing expression, good front and moved well; 2 My Count of W; 3 Bradley's Pinmoney Problem, nice younger standing but didn't move well. **Nov D (7):** 1 3623, I have no details of name or owner. Good head and expression, nice front, needs to body up; 2 Whitworth's The Vicar of Raventofts, well-boned, up to size, harsh coat, moved well; 3 My Count of W. **Grad D (10):** 1 Dennis's Slitrig Go Shell of Branson, quality dog, nice outline and bone, good front and feet. Needs to body up, moved well; 2 3623; 3 Beel's Phlurry O'Petriburg, smaller, very neat, lovely white coat, good head and expression. **Open D (12):** 1 Bertram's Highstile Prank, stylish, looking his very best and I gave him the CC and BOB, looked a complete dog with good head carriage, nice neck and shoulders, deep body, good quarters and moved well, very white; 2 Cook and Silfvast's Famecheck Bernard, well-known and well-made, smaller than I like, res CC; 3 Millen's Lindenhall Drambuie, attractive with very good head and expression, well made body, moved nicely, shade big.

Puppy B (7): 1 Begg's Danelea Dawn, very white, attractive head, short back and moved well, needs time; 2 Cook's Famecheck Maid to Order, good bodied youngster. Failed in head and colour; 3 Watson's Dunearn Darringer, another nice bodied puppy, pretty head. Not so good in front. **Jun B (11):** 1 Cleland's Birkfell Solace, well-grown, natural shower, nice head and expression, very good eye, moved freely; 2 Morgan's Ballacour Ballerina, not so short in back as winner, but attractive and well made, moved nicely; 3 Dennis's Beautiful Biddy of Branson neat with nice outline. Didn't show to advantage. **Nov B (16):** 1 Beautiful Biddy of B; 2 Vernon's Lovely Lady of Balmaha, attractive head, good movement. Failed in front; 3 Whitworth's The Nun of Raventofts, well made bitch, not so short in back, harsh coat. **Grad B (10):** 1 B Ballerina; 2 Cook's Famecheck Dresden, stockily built, good bone, rather small; 3 Lovely Lady of B. **Open B (7):** 1 Cleland's Birkfell Seafire, I have always liked this attractive and feminine bitch and today she looked and showed well. Pleased to give her the CC; 2 Griffin's Shandwin Sazariah, nice head and expression, good neck and shoulders, moved nicely, res CC; 3 Milner's Sollershot Solray, another well-known bitch. Lost in colour and not very interested.

In Open B I would have liked extra cards as it was a very strong class to judge. **Dogs.—Jun:** 1 Millen's Lindenhall Drambuie, nice type, short-coupled, nice level topline, very white coat. 2 Cook's Famecheck Solomon, good head, well placed ears, good colour, front could have been better. 3 Bourchier's Urselspryde Burlington Bert, quite nice, did not move very well. **Nov:** 1 L Drambuie, 2 F Solomon, 3 Fisher's Slitrig Superflash, rather gay tail, otherwise quite a nice type. **Limit:** 1 Watson's Dunearn Pinkholme Panorama, good head, neck & shoulders & front, good short back, well set on tail. 2 Graham & Hazell's Lasara Leroy, nice head & ears, dark eye, harsh coat, close up. 3 F Solomon. **Open:** 1 Cook's Famecheck Hallmark, smart dog, good head, neat ears, beautiful dark eye, movement good, full of quality; cc & b.o.b. 2 Kearsay's Pillerton Peterman, another smart dog, unlucky to meet winner; res cc. 3 D P Panorama. **Bitches.—Jun:** 1 Beel's Paulette o' Petriburg, quality bitch, good head, dark eye, short-coupled, good mover. 2 Hartwell's St Loyes Capability Brown, another nice bitch, good head, small dark eye, neat ears, good mover, unlucky to meet winner. 3 Hartwell's St Loyes Gloribee, litter sister to above, quite a nice type, but not the quality of her sister. **Nov:** 1 Paulette o' P. 2 St L C Brown. 3 Black's Strathairlie Silver Dawn, nice type, good head, short coupled. **Limit:** 1 Cook's Famecheck Verona, good head, nice short deep body, good tall carriage, very hard pure white coat. 2 Winder's Ellenside Eldelweiss, good type, did not move as well as above. 3 Wilson's Rhianfa Rainsborow Poppea, good type, could have been better presented. **Open:** 1 Kearsay's Pillerton Peta, stylish bitch, good head, neck & body, nice level topline, moved well; cc. 2 Black's Strathairlie Swiss Miss, stylish bitch, typical ears & expression, ooslon, close up; res cc. 3 Clelland's Birkfell Seafire, another nice bitch, good shower, but have seen her in better form.—J Herbert.

Spec puppy D (5): 1 Fisher's Lindenhall Discord; 2 Wallace's Morenish Geordie; 3 Bryan's Alvermar Admiral. **Nov D (12):** 1 Wysocki's Rhianfa Ambassador; 2 Collett's Cedarfell Man o' Minx; 3 Fenton's Royal Ridge of Ranrou. **Grad D (11):** 1 Dennis's Slitrig Goshell of Branson; 2 Cook's Famecheck Knight Errant; 3 Berry's Incheril Ishca. **Mid Limit D (14):** 1 Millen's Lindenhall Drambuie; 2 S Goshell of B; 3 I Ishca. **Open D (16):** 1 Wheeler's Ch Alpinegay Impresario; 2 Sansom's Ch Quakertown Quistador; 3 Zakschewski's Eng and Int Ch Monsieur Aus Der Fler.

In the nice entry of 78, I thought the bitches were of better quality than the dogs. I was sorry to see two exhibits with one incisor missing. This is a very bad fault and must be checked now before we get narrow jaws and cramped teeth. The lack of muscle in hindquarters is responsible for most of the poor movement particularly in the dog classes.

Puppy D (5): 1 Wheeler's Alpinegay Sonata, good type, pleasing head, although his ears could be used better. Well laid shoulders, short back, coat of good texture and colour; 2 Cook's Famecheck Man o' Mark, well matured puppy, harsh coat. Failed in hind action to winner; 3 Farthing's My Count of Weatherly, very attractive dog standing but has a tendency to plaiting front action. **Nov D (7):** 1 Winder's Beaconsfield Debonair, deep bodied, stocky little dog, showy, sound movement; 2 Wilson's Macrab of Balmaha, good head, well made but needs more body and coat; 3 A Sonata. **Post Grad D (8):** 1 Thompson's Perfect O' Petriburg, really good type, nice outline, needs time to get that extra body, good mover; 2 Beel's Phlurry O' Petriburg, similar in type to above but did not show to best advantage; 3 Lewis's Glengordon Monopoly, rather bigger than most, good white coat, strong quarters. **Minor Limit D (7):** 1 Cook's Famecheck Bernard, handsome dog, stood out in this class, won res CC. I like very much and would like him even more with a little more daylight underneath; 2 Perfect O' P; 3 Phlurry O' P. **Open D (4):** 1 Dickinson's Pinkholme Paramount, very much improved dog to whom I was glad to award his third CC. Nice head, excellent neck and shoulders, level topline, wellset on tail, whitest coat possible; 2 Cook's Famecheck Hallmark, stylish but rather small for me; 3 Millen's Lindenhall Drambuie immediately takes the eye, shows with confidence but too big for my taste. This class provided a bigger variety in size than any other.

Puppy B (11): 1 Kearsay's Pillerton Pixie and 2 Pritchard's Pillerton Picture, these two turned out to be litter sisters and were very hard to separate. Pleasing types, good all over, Pixie just had the edge in maturity; 3 Wheeler's Alpinegay Ramona, not in such good condition today but a typey sort that will have a better day. Straight white coat. **Nov B (14):** 1 Vernon's Lovely Lady of Balmaha, res CC, outstanding one. Near perfect movement, good thrusting drive, exceptionally good hard coat; 2 Beard's Strathairlie Sweet Briar, appealed to me at once. Good head set on muscular neck, short back and tail, when her coat is in better trim should do

well; 3 Ingram's Woodpuddle Baubles, smart, showy, little plainer in head than some perhaps. **Post Grad B (7):** 1 Lovely Lady of B; 2 Wheeler's Alpinegay Quartette, another good one of the type we have come to associate with this kennel; 3 Cook's Maid to Measure, good bodied bitch, hind action did not please. **Minor Limit B (4):** 1 A Quartette; 2 Griffin's Shandwin Sazariah, good head, neck and shoulders, level topline, good quarters. Presentation could be better; 3 Bingham's Shadywell Topsy, sorry no notes on this. **Open B (7):** 1 Black's Strathairlie Swiss Miss, won the CC, BOB and gained her title. Looking better than I have ever seen her. Has matured in body and moved very well; 2 Ingram's Woodpuddle Bawbee, well known, always moves and shows well, neat, compact; 3 Coy's Whitebriar Jillian, heavily made, good head and coat, failed in hind action to those above.
